

PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS

Processed Road Material Hauling

The City of Bryson will be accepting sealed bids for selecting a single source provider for hauling processed flexible base road construction material. This will consist of road material to be hauled from one or two processing sites to the City of Bryson utilizing belly dump trailers only. The fee will be paid for this hauling will be at the bid price per load. That price will be for truck unit, when loaded with material, of one operator and one belly dump trailer. It is expected that a proponent may haul as many as 8 to 10 loads per day.

It is estimated that the shortest haul might be as short as 7 miles and longest haul approximately 10 miles. The City of Bryson may designate routes of travel. The City may utilize as few as one (1) truck per day and as many as three (3) trucks per day. There is no guarantee to any proponents as to the number of loads to be made per day or in total.

The City of Bryson reserves the right to accept any, all, or none of the proposals hereunder. The City of Bryson reserves the right to terminate this agreement with any accepted proponent for any or no reason. The City of Bryson will give not less than 48 hour notice as to when, where and the number of trucks needed. Successful bidder (contractor) will be required to provide liability insurance coverage in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00. Insurance shall be appropriate for the work being performed and as well provide protection from claims which may arise out of or result from contractor's other obligations whether it is to be performed by contractor, any subcontractor or supplier, or by anyone of them to perform any of the work, or by anyone for whose acts of any of them may be liable. Said certificate of insurance will be delivered to City of Bryson prior to commencement of work and maintained by proponent during the course of the agreement. The City of Bryson is not liable, or responsible for any damage or accidents resulting from the work of the contractor, subcontractor or supplier, or by anyone of them performing the work under the proponent of the contract.

Materials hauled will be specified by the Public Works Director at quarries in and around Jack County. Quarry personnel will be familiar on their site as to the materials to be transported. Each proponent will keep good paperwork document work done and location.

Proponents will be responsible to submit paperwork to the City of Bryson showing amount of material loaded and road projects to which they are hauled.

The original contract period will be for one (1) year, beginning on January 1, 2017 and ending on January 1, 2018 with one additional extension of one year, subject to agreement by both parties. Proponent must utilize BID SHEET as provided herein and comply with all terms of the LEGAL NOTICE, also included in bid packet.

Based on sufficient evidence, provided by contractor, a fuel cost adjustment may be negotiated every 180 days and paid by City of Bryson as approved by the City Council of Bryson, Texas.
