IX. Motion was made to adopt a new city ordinance prohibiting the mobile homes into the city limits with a rolling age of twenty (20) plus years by Ald. JR Stearns; seconded by Ald. Heather Neer. Vote 5-0

X. Motion was made to proceed with clean-up at 103 N McCloud and to receive bids for clean up at 101 Locust St and 307 S Depot by Ald. Heather Neer; seconded by Ald. JR Stearns. Vote 5-0

XI. Council moved into Executive Session at 8:04 pm to discuss employee raises. Council moved out of Executive Session at 8:29 pm.



XIII. Discuss Spring Cleanup: April 14th and 15th will be free dump days for city residents.


