- VIII. Motion was made to approve the call for the May 6, 2023 General Election for Mayor and two Aldermen by Shelly Tinney; seconded by Ald. Heather Neer. Vote 5-0
- IX. Motion was made to adopt a new city ordinance prohibiting the mobile homes into the city limits with a rolling age of twenty (20) plus years by Ald. JR Stearns; seconded by Ald. Heather Neer. Vote 5-0
- X. Motion was made to proceed with clean-up at 103 N McCloud and to receive bids for clean up at 101 Locust St and 307 S Depot by Ald. Heather Neer; seconded by Ald. JR Stearns. Vote 5-0
- XI. Council moved into Executive Session at 8:04 pm to discuss employee raises. Council moved out of Executive Session at 8:29 pm.
- XII. Motion and second was made to approve a 7% pay raise for the PWD Assistant and City secretary to be effective immediately and a 7% pay raise for the PWD upon completion of required licenses. Vote 5-0
